



MB Engineering Modern Rally Championship



Sixty and Worcestershire motor club is to run a Single make Esports championship in Dirt Rally 2.0 for fully paid-up members of Sixty and Worcestershire Motor Club and members of any motor club that is an affiliated member of any of the regional associations listed below:

- CMSG (Cotswold Motor Sport Group)
- ASWMC (Association of South West Motor Clubs)
- ANWCC (Association of North Western Car Clubs)
- WAMC (Welsh Association of Motor Clubs)
- AWMMC (Association of West Midland Motor Clubs).

The championship is open to members on any platform.

This championship is a scoring round of the Sixty and Worcestershire Motor Club esports championship.

All entry fees will be donated in full to a charity of the motor clubs choosing, this charity will be determined by club members at the 2021 club AGM.

Title sponsor MB Engineering is also offering a single use voucher for 10% off any of their services for all entrants, this will be sent out to competitors after their entry has been accepted. Visit www.mbengineering.uk for more details of the work on offer.

1. The events shall take place on Dirt Rally 2.0.
2. Entry will cost a minimum of £5 although you can donate as much as you like which will be donated in full to the chosen charity.
3. A £15 minimum payment can be made that will cover entry for all four championship events this year.
4. The events will consist of 5-8 stages in different locations and varying conditions (Some of which may be 'dlc' (extra paid content) locations).
5. The final round of the Championship will be a full night event with every stage in the dark and an increase to 10 stages. This event will be worth double points and with shorter service intervals between stages this will be a serious challenge for competitors.
6. Competitors can also play 'Joker Points' on one event from the championship excluding the Double points final round. Competitors must declare their choice to play their joker before the event begins.
7. Competitors will compete in one of 2 classes, Expert and Novice. Expert is defined as any competitor who has finished in the top 3 in the Overalls of a sixty and Worcester eSports round more than once or has finished 1st in the novice championship. Novice is any competitor who is not eligible as Expert.
8. For those who have not taken part before, your class will be defined by the results of the first 2 runs that you partake. Unless you wish to declare yourself as an Expert during registration.
9. Assists (traction control and abs etc.) are free in order to make it as accessible as possible to all entrants.
10. There will be a total of 5 rounds running weekly starting from the 26th January with the Final round starting 23rd February and running until the 4th February. The events will run from 10:00 Tuesday till 23:59 Thursday. The stages for each round will be announced on the Monday before the round starts.
11. The Championship will consist of:
 - Round 1: Monte Carlo, Monaco Car, Class: R5 26th Jan – 28th Jan
 - Round 2: New England, USA, Car Class: R2 2nd Feb – 4th Feb
 - Round 3: Catamarca Province, Argentina, Car Class: NR4/R4 9th Feb – 11th Feb
 - Round 4: Ribadelles, Spain, Car Class: R2 16th Feb – 18th Feb
 - Round 5: Perth and Kinross, Scotland, Car Class: 4WD up to 2000cc 23rd Feb – 25th Feb

12. Due to the way the Dirt 2.0 clubs feature works you will have one attempt at each stage during an event so make sure to get any practice in before attempting the event.

13. Scoring will follow the WRC scoring system which is as follows:

1st 25 points

2nd 18 points

3rd 15 points

4th 12 points

5th 10 points

6th 8 points

7th 6 points

8th 4 points

9th 2 points

10th 1 point

14. Competitors will also receive an additional 5 points for the completion of each round.

15. There will also be power stage points available in each class for the fastest stage time on the final stage of each round. The points available are as follows:

Fastest stage time 5 points

2nd fastest stage time 4 points

3rd fastest stage time 3 points

4th fastest stage time 2 points

5th fastest stage time 1 point

16. We have prizes to offer for 1st overall, the highest placing Sixty and Worcester club member and 1st in each class. The prizes are tbc at this time. Competitors may not win more than one award.
