

Castlemorton Grass Autotest – Sept 20th 2020

Supplementary Regulations



1. The Sixty & Worcestershire Motor Club will organise a Clubman's Grass Autotest on Sunday September 20th 2020 at Mill Farm, Castlemorton, Malvern, WR13 6BQ map ref 150/783372. We are very grateful to the local land owner for the use of these premises.
2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the MSUK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. Motorsport UK Permit has been issued No. 118647.

The event will be open to all fully elected members of the organising club and members of clubs affiliated to Cotswold Motor Sport Group (CMSG).

Non-members must join Sixty & Worcestershire MC, from the club website, no later than Thursday 17th September 2020, no club memberships will be issued on the day of the event.

All competitors and passengers need to hold a new RS Clubman licence as a minimum from 2020, in order to compete in a Motorsport UK permitted event. Apply on-line at <https://www.motorsportuk.org> No licence applications will be accepted on the day of the event and it is recommended that when applying you allow at least 10 days.

The event is a round of the Sixty & Worcestershire Motor Club Off-Road Championship.

4. Motorsport UK Covid-19 related items;
There will be no signing-on at the start venue, therefore the following must be adhered to prior to the event to enable your entry to be proceed;
Entry form and fee to be submit to Secretary of the Meeting no later than 21:00 September 17th 2020, along with the following document;
All Competitors must read and sign the Motorsports UK document – '2020-05-18-pre-event-declaration-competitor-web-v11.pdf', supplied as part of these regulations and downloaded by the club website,
Provide a scan/photo of your current Club Card (non Sixty & Worcs MC only),
Provide a scan/photo of your current MSUK Licence.

All correspondence will initially be by email.

At the time of publication, Motorsports UK have instructed that there will be NO Vehicle Sharing accept where 2 people are considered to share the same social bubble, i.e. same family, partners etc.

Timing & Results;

No time/score cards to be passed between competitor and officials; the start/finish marshal will not record the competitors time on the competitor's timesheet in the traditional way, instead the marshal will record the time on a master timesheet and verbally communicate to the competitor the start and finish time,

Each competitor will be supplied with a A4 sheet with test boxes, these are to enable to competitor to record their own times from the verbal communication from the start/finish marshal.

Results & timing will use the on-line service provided by Sapphire Solutions.

Event Control/ Administration;

PPE in line with Government advice and area sanitation regularly required

Personnel limited for social distancing at recommended 2 metre,

Competitors - ALL DRIVERS:

Any driver involved in an incident must indicate that they are OK by signalling with a "thumbs up" at the front windscreen at the earliest opportunity to the approaching marshal

If competitors can safely exit the vehicle, they should do so, then stand in a suitable location and respect social distancing

Social distancing to be respected whilst walking sections/ tests.

Competitor/ Briefings; will take place in the open and the 2m rule applies. Where possible the need for hand sanitisers will be available for/at Officials & Marshalling points only. It is the competitor's responsibility to provide hand sanitiser within the car interior.

NO Spectators are allowed on this event, people will be asked to leave the venue!

5. The events will consist of classes as follows
 - A. Front wheel drive
 - B. Rear wheel drive

No four-wheel drive vehicles are allowed.

Cars need not be MOT'd or taxed.

6. All vehicles must comply with **Motorsport UK** Technical Regulations. Vehicles must compete on road legal tyres. No M&S, T+C or 'grip' tyres will be allowed.

7. The programme of the meeting will be:

Thursday 17th September 2020 – Entry close at 21:00

Friday 18th September 2020 – Finals and all paperwork issued to competitors.

Sunday 20th September 2020;

Opens at 09:00.

Drivers Briefing at 09:45.

First Car starts approx. 10:00. Any driver who does not present themselves at the first test will be assumed as a non-starter.

Finish time approx. 16:00

8. Awards will be presented as follows;

Fastest Time of the Day

First in each class (Subject to three starters)

Second in each Class (Subject to six starters)

A special award may be given to the driver who provides the most entertainment!

No Competitor can win more than one award.

Awards will then be presented once the tests are removed, we would appreciate your help in packing away.

9. Entries open on publication of the regulations and close finally on Thursday September 17th 2020 at 21:00.

All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the entry fee of £20.00.

10. The maximum entry for the meeting is 40 the minimum is 10: should the minimum figure not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the meeting.

There is no minimum class entry and classes may be amalgamated.

Entries will be selected in order of receipt.

Double entries are allowed but no car may be entered by more than two drivers. Passengers are allowed but if you elect to do so, you must take a passenger every time.

Passengers must be over the age of 14, all passengers must be signed on. Please see the Motorsport UK regulations on minimum ages. If the driver is unlicensed, then the passenger must be.

All Officials of the event will also be "Judges of Fact ". A list will be published at signing on. Judges of Fact decisions are final.

12. Provisional Results will be on display throughout the day, Sapphire Solutions on-line results will be used and a link to the portal will be supplied in the Finals.

Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event and declared final as D26.3 (30 minutes).

Any protest must be lodged in accordance with C5.1 to 5.7.

13. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be supplied by the organiser. They must be displayed on both sides of the vehicle preferably in the side windows or closest equivalent.

ALL Competitors will be requested to marshal during the event, any competitor failing to do so, will be given a maximum for that set of tests.

Each competitor will have two attempts at each course; their fastest run will count for results. In the event of a tie, the fastest run on the first course will determine the tie then the second fastest run on the first course, then the fastest run on the second course etc. until the tie is resolved. To be classified as a finisher a competitor must start at least two runs of all courses. (Only one run of the final course if the event is cut short).

14. Marking and penalties will be as follows;

Some tests may include stop/restart sections

Time taken completing the course - **Actual time taken**

Touching a cone or barrier or any other course marker - **5 seconds per offence**

Not stopping astride the finishing line – **5 seconds**

Taking an incorrect route on any course - **Maximum time** (however, returning to the point of departure from the correct route and then completing the route correctly will not be penalised, except as immediately below)

Completing a course in a time exceeding the maximum - **Maximum time**

Not stopping immediately on deployment of the STOP signal - **Maximum time**

The Maximum time is the quickest time in class for that course plus **twenty seconds**.

15. The courses will be depicted by cones or stacks/poles and marker tape. Course diagrams will be in the competitor's pack, which will be issued after successful completion of signing on. Pylons or cones may be less than a metre high.

Driving behaviour of all competitors will be observed at all times. Reckless, inconsiderate or dangerous behaviour, or exceeding the site speed limit will result in the exclusion of the competitor concerned. We will not allow foolish behaviour to jeopardise our use of this venue. Please co-operate in this regard.

16. The starting signal will be "In your own time". Timing will be by hand held devices. Tests will be timed to the previous tenth of a second. Timing will start as the car moves away from the timing start line, and stop when the front wheels stop astride the finish line.
17. Please ensure the vehicle is properly silenced to comply with J5.17 (88dB at 4,500 rpm, measured from 2Metres).
18. The STOP signal may be displayed because of an obstruction on the course, whether this be object or personnel. A competitor must stop immediately on deployment of the STOP signal and a re-run will be allowed. The STOP signal will be demonstrated at the driver's briefing. All other General Regulations of Motorsport UK apply as written, except that a) All competitors must walk each course before the timed runs start for that course b) No practicing will be allowed.
