This year's entrants will enjoy a breakfast bacon/sausage bap along with Tea/Coffee at our popular start and Finish venue. Worcester RFC based very close to Junction 6 of the M5 will be our base for the event. The Rugby Club are looking forward to hosting the event at their impressive venue which we are sure everyone will enjoy. After approximately 115 miles the tour will return to the Rugby Club for a choice of hot food. and the awarding of our trophy for the favourite car of the tour, voted by entrants and organisers.

During the Tour we have arranged for refreshment halts which we are sure you will find interesting with the theme of Cars at both stops. In a change from previous years we are running four sections, with each section covering approximately 30 miles. At each stop we have arranged for tea/coffee etc.

The tour offers some fantastic scenery in parts of Worcestershire that includes famous historic properties along the way. You will receive a tulip style roadbook, a vehicle tour plate, and vouchers for your Breakfast Bap, coffee and cake stop, cream tea stop, and finally the meal at the finish.

SIXTY & WORCESTERSHIRE MOTOR CLUB LTD

1. The Sixty and Worcestershire Motor Club will organise a Touring Assembly on Sunday 28th June 2026 entitled The Greenleaves Classic Tour. Starting and finishing at Worcester RFC Offerton Lane, Worcester.
2. The event will be held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) these Supplementary Regulations, and any written instructions that the organising club issue for the event.
3. A Certificate of Exemption has been applied for.
4. The event is open to all members of the Sixty & Worcestershire Motor Club, members of the Historic Rally Car Register. In addition, members of the public are welcome to participate (NCR Chapter 3 App.7 Art 1.2)
5. The event is open to cars first registered before 1<sup>st</sup> January 2000. Other interesting later cars may be accepted at the organiser's discretion.
6. All cars must be taxed, hold a V5C Registration Document and have a valid MOT Certificate, where appropriate. Cars must not display any advertising or carry any competition numbers on the doors.
7. The Greenleaves Classic Tour is included in the HRCR Scenic Tour Series 2026 kindly supported by Monit Motorsport.
8. All drivers must produce a valid driving license for the car being driven.

Entries open on 1<sup>st</sup> May at 18:00., and close finally on Tuesday 23rd June. All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the entry fee of £115 for two people travelling in the car. Please add £25 for each additional person. Each entry will be acknowledged, and where possible all correspondence will be by e-mail. Entries will be taken via Rallies.info. please use the following link.

Final instructions will be sent out during the week prior to the event.

9. The entry fee includes a road book, one rigid participating vehicle plate, breakfast roll and coffee/tea at the start, coffee/tea/biscuits at the morning and afternoon stops, and a buffet style meal at the finish.

The maximum number of cars on the event is Sixty, the minimum is twenty. Should the minimum figure not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event and entry fees will be refunded in full. Entries will be selected in order of receipt, and the running order will be decided by the organisers. If an entrant wants to run close to a friend/colleague, then please note on the entry form. 11. The start and Finish venue will be Worcester RFC, Offerton Lane, Worcester WR3 8TR or Map Ref. 150/579894 or What3Words [\\buggy.unloaded.question](https://www.what3words.com/buggy.unloaded.question)

The route will be approximately 120 miles in Worcestershire & Warwickshire and will be split into four sections as defined in an easy to follow Tulip style road book issued to entrants at the start. Although not required to complete the route entrants might like to follow their progress on Ordnance Survey "Landranger" maps 151 & 150.

12. The first car will start at 09:30. The others will leave in number order at one minute intervals. There will be a course closing car who will be travelling the entire route.

13. Along the route there will be check points and code boards to observe the entrant's adherence to the defined route. At each check point the entrant's Route Check Card will be signed for route verification purposes only.

14. The programme for the meeting will be:

15. Cars and entrants must arrive at the start no later than 09:00

The following documents must be available for inspection :

Driving licence for the driver

V5C Registration Certificate for the car being used

Current vehicle MOT certificate (if required) for the car being used

16. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that their vehicle is taxed and insured, you will be required to sign a declaration to this effect at documentation.

17. Any vehicle which, in the opinion of the organisers, is deemed inappropriate or unsafe, will not be allowed to start.
18. After documentation, entrants will be given their Vehicle Identity Plate with cable ties, Road Book, Route Check Card and food vouchers.

20. Entrants will be identified by a vehicle commemorative plate supplied at documentation. This must be displayed in a prominent forward facing position on the vehicle. Cable ties will be provided.
21. All marshals will be deemed to be judges of fact.
22. There will be only one award, The Worcester Evening News Cup. This will be for “the car you would most like to drive home” (other than your own) and will be voted for by entrants themselves, together with Marshals and organisers. The winning driver will receive a souvenir award to take home.
23. The Sixty & Worcestershire Motor Club are committed to meeting its Motorsport UK sustainability requirements and ask all entrants to respect all requests for minimising environmental impact and making the event litter free. Entrants may be asked to complete a short impact survey on completion of the event.
