1. Sixty & Worcestershire Motor Club will organise a Navigational Treasure Hunt on Friday 16th October 2026.
2. The event will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the Sporting Code of the FIA), by these supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for this event.
3. Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption No. 208745 has been issued.
4. The event is open to members of the organising club and anyone else. It is not a requirement to be a club member or for participants to hold a competition licence.
5. Entries open with the publication of these regulations and will be accepted in order of receipt. Entries will be limited to 12 cars.
6. The entry fee is £10-00 per car. Payable by BACS to Lloyds Bank 30-97-77, 23335268 or Paypal to sales@sixtyworcsmc.co.uk Please include the event name and your name within the payment detail. Reluctantly Cash and Cheques can no longer be accepted
7. Entries close at 19-00 hrs on Wednesday 14th October

9. The programme for the meeting will be as follows:-
Entries close 19-00 hrs Wed 14th October
Final instructions sent out Thursday 15th October (by e-mail)
Route Cards issued 19-30 hrs Friday 16th October
The start will be a layby on the A4103 near Leigh Sinton Map Ref 150/765496
10. The finish will be at a pub
11. A map will be provided, but you may like to use your own O.S. map 150
12. Instructions will include map references, tulip diagrams, spot heights, grid lines, Herringbones, junction colours and map symbols and to make it more interesting there will be code boards and/or secret checks at undisclosed locations. The final instructions will include examples of each type of navigation.
13. The route will be timed at 10 mph. anyone arriving at the finish after 21-30 will be penalised.
14. There will be two classes Experts and Novices
Experts are a crew where any member has finished in the top three of ANY rally or Navex in the last 5 years in any capacity.
Novices will be all others. Novices will receive a marked map showing the correct route.
15. All crews will receive their route instructions at the same time
16. All vehicles must be road legal and be taxed and insured.
17. It is recommended that competitors carry a spill kit to minimise the impact of any spillage.
18. Penalties. Except for arriving at the finish there will be no real timing and you may travel at your own pace.

Missing a Passage Control/code board or getting an answer incorrect	0 points
Arriving at the finish after 21-30	1 point per minute
Arriving at the finish after 22-00	Exclusion
19. Each correct answer will receive 10 points. The winner will be the crew with the highest score.
20. Ties will be decided by furthest cleanest and then by a deciding question at the end of the route card.
If a tie still exists then it will remain a tie.
21. Results will be announced as soon as possible at the end of the event and will be sent out to competitors by e-mail on Monday 19th October.
22. In the spirit of the event protests will not be accepted.
